Section 1: What is IELTS and Who Conducts It?

- It is jointly managed by the British Council, IDP: IELTS Australia, and Cambridge Assessment English.
- IELTS assesses the English language proficiency of non-native English speakers.

Format of the Exam

- The IELTS exam consists of four sections: Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking.
- The Listening and Speaking sections are the same for both Academic and General Training versions, while the Reading and Writing sections differ.
- The Listening section comprises four recordings of native English speakers, with a variety of accents.
- The Reading section includes three long texts ranging from descriptive and factual to discursive and analytical.
- The Writing section requires candidates to complete two tasks: Task 1 (Report Writing) and Task 2 (Essay Writing).
- The Speaking section consists of a face-to-face interview with a certified examiner.

Section 2: Strategies to Master the Exam

- Understand the Test Format: Familiarize yourself with the test format, question types, and timing for each section.
- Practice Regularly: Practice listening to English podcasts, reading academic articles, writing essays, and engaging in speaking activities.
