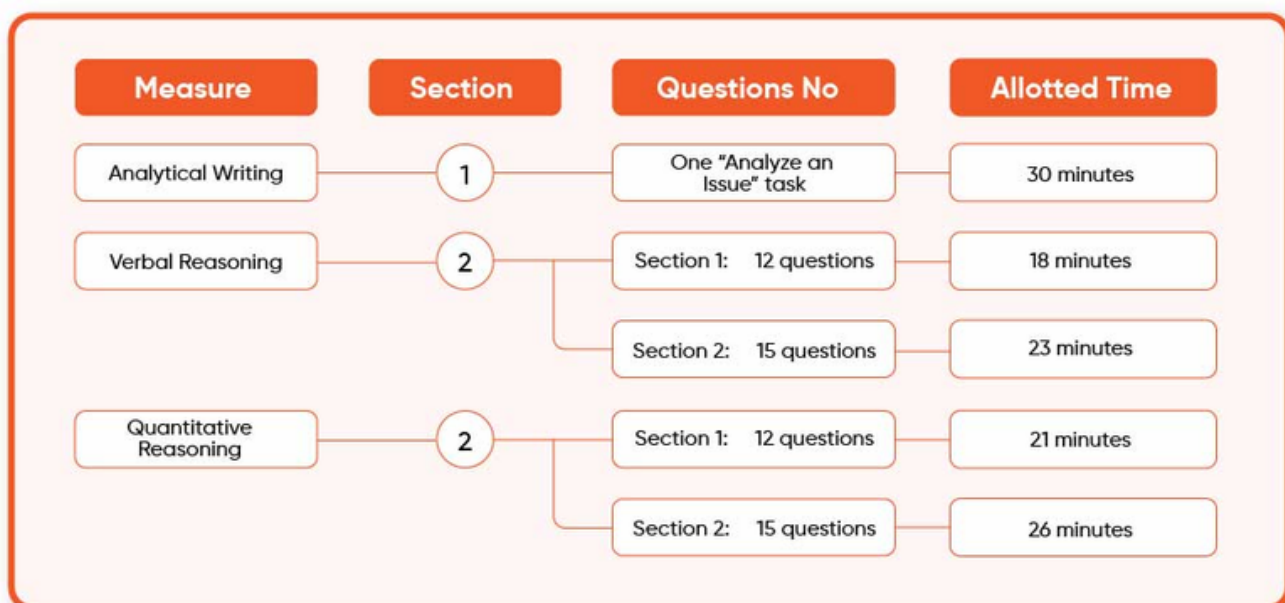

Section 1: What is GRE?

1. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) is a standardized test conducted by the Educational Testing Service (ETS). It assesses a student's readiness for graduate-level academic study and is widely accepted by universities and colleges around the globe.
2. Format of the Exam:
3. The GRE consists of three main sections: Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, and Analytical Writing. The Verbal and Quantitative sections are scored on a scale of 130-170, while the Analytical Writing section is scored on a scale of 0-6.

Most universities require candidates to submit GRE General test though the Subject test may be necessary for some specializations. For pursuing such specializations, both GRE General test and the GRE Subject test must be submitted.

The amount of time needed for your results to arrive depends on the mode of examination you took. The result of a paper test may take up to 6 weeks for the result to arrive through the mail. The Computer test results arrive within 2 weeks.

GRE Scores Validity

GRE Score validity is for Five years. Educational Testing Service keeps your scores on file for 5 years. If you take the Exam on March 1, 2023, the result of the GRE is valid up to March 1, 2028. When the 5 years pass, Educational Testing Services automatically delete them and you would not be able to access your GRE account again.
