

### Section 3: Eligibility for Indian Students

- Academic Requirements
- 12th Grade Completion: Students must have completed their 12th grade with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as core subjects.
- **Minimum Marks:** A minimum aggregate score of 50% in PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) is generally required.
- **NEET Qualification:** Clearing the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) is mandatory for Indian students to pursue MBBS abroad.
- Language Proficiency
- English Proficiency: Many countries require proof of English proficiency through exams like IELTS or TOEFL.
- Language of Instruction: Some countries may require basic proficiency in the local language for better communication during clinical practice.
- Entrance Examinations
- University-Specific Tests: Some universities may have their own entrance exams or additional requirements for admission. Eg: Italy requires IMAT and US asks for MCAT scores. (Connect for more details)
